

THE ALBANY CLASSIC MOTOR EVENT WEEKEND
May 31st - JUNE 1st 2014

Dear Club Member,

You are cordially invited to participate in the 2014 Albany Classic Motor Event Weekend of motor-sport. On Saturday 31st May there will be the Mt Clarence Hill-climb, a multi-club event in which entry preference will be given to VSCCWA Club members and to bona fide Albany region entrants. On Sunday the 1st June there will be the iconic "round the houses" Albany Classic, restricted, as always to CAMS 5th Category cars of Cams-affiliated Club members and some invited guests. Preference will be given to VSCCWA Club Members. This event will also be a round of the 2014 CAMS WA Historic Regularity Drivers Championship. Please read the enclosed Supplementary Regulation for all events carefully, in conjunction with the VSCCWA Standing Regulations 2014, and the 2014 CAMS WA Historic Regularity Drivers Championship Standing Regulations.

Because there was some delay in getting the necessary approvals, we have left issue of these documents to very late: there is not much time to the **CLOSING DATE OF 25th April**, SO GET YOUR ENTRY IN STRAIGHT AWAY.

On the Entry Form you are invited to submit a "Suggested Lap Time" (for the Round the Houses) which will be considered with other data, such as the 130% speed differential for your fields and the Regularity requirement to not exceed 85% of "race speed", to arrive at a lap time which will be nominated for you. The purpose of this exercise is to reduce the time required between the end of practice and the beginning of competition for altered data to be inputted to the Timing computer. As always, you will have the opportunity after practice to alter you nominated time, via consultation with your team leader. I urge you to submit sensible times, as the task of dealing with data for ~150 drivers is Herculean in nature, and you know that, in the end, times will need to be acceptable to CAMS Officials.

You are also asked on the Entry Form to nominate a place of Scrutiny, which will be available in Albany and Bunbury regions as for Perth on Saturday 24th May. For other country entrants, scrutiny will be available on the Saturday morning at the Mt Clarence Paddock and Sunday morning in the pits for those unable to attend any previous time. Those entering the Mt Clarence Hillclimb and needing Saturday morning scrutiny will be assigned to a later group in the hillclimb. Firm detail will come with your acceptance of entry letter.

This year there will be a Trophy Presentation Dinner on the Sunday night, with Trophies for event winners of the day. It is intended that there will be free wine tasting on arrival, followed by a hot smorgasbord dinner, presentations and live music. It will be a fun night with table prizes and of course drinks available for purchase at the bar. This event is being kindly supported by, and held at, the Motel Le Grande. The cost is \$40 per head, which includes the dinner, wine tasting and entertainment.
