You are cordially invited to attend/enter the 2013 VSCCWA Coalfields 500 Weekend, which will be a multi-club extravaganza involving a Hillclimb, Race events and Regularity events – run in one, or run in all, or any combination – your choice. If you're not a member of a CAMS-affiliated Club, temporary VSCCWA membership is available and temporary CAMS 2SE driving licence may be available to people holding a street license.

Proposed program SATURDAY 28TH

The Hillclimb will commence on the 2.35km private roads Collie Motorplex Hillclimb Circuit at 9:00am, after a driver's briefing at 8:45am. There will be a practice and four timed runs, all things being equal. All vehicles as per the 2013 VSCC Standing Regulations for Hillclimbs and Sprints Club Championship will be eligible for entry. There will be a limit of 90 cars on a first in best dressed basis.

Meanwhile, over on the main circuit, Race Qualifying will begin at 11:00am after a 10:30am drivers briefing. There may be four race groups, and after lunch there will be two rounds of racing. Every effort will be made to ensure that Race entrants get to finish their Hillclimb in time to get to Qualifying. Regularity Practice will begin at 1:40pm after a 1:30pm drivers briefing, and again there may be four Regularity groups, who will conclude the day with a round of Regularity competition. There will be a Social Event in the Collie Motorsport Group Clubhouse at the track on Saturday night, with a barbecue to kick off with. We can provide you with a meat pack, buns, salads etc for a nourishing meal. - \$15/head will get you a ticket to this (see entry form). Later there will be a band (probably rock 'n roll) and an "open microphone" opportunity, so you're invited to bring a musical instrument to play along. Drinks will have to be "bring your own"

Proposed program SUNDAY 29TH

There will be the usual compulsory Drivers Briefing at 8:30am with Practice/Qualifying, for those that need it, starting at 9:am, followed by three rounds of each Race and Regularity to conclude by 4:00pm so you could be home before dark. It is a long weekend, so you might choose to stay on and enjoy the attractions that Collie has to offer.

Camping Out:

The camping area, with access to hot showers, kitchen, barbeque and the CMG club room will be available, as will the bunkhouse (byo bed & bedding) for up to 10 people, all at \$10/head per night payable to Motoring South West.
