


GOOMALLING FLYER 2012.

The Shire of Goomalling has commissioned a book recounting the proud history of Round the Houses Motor-racing in that town from 1949 to 1953, written by VSCCWA member Graeme Cocks.

To launch the book, and celebrate the history, the Shire has invited The Vintage Sports Car Club of WA to run a small event in the town on **Sunday March 11 2012**. Despite the difficulties of arranging insurance for such an event in this day and age, we are proud to announce a garage-finish sprint to take place on Railway Terrace Goomalling on that day and invite your attendance and/or participation to make this a noteworthy day in the history of Goomalling. There will be a short ceremony to launch the book at about 11:30am on the corner of Hoddy and Railway Terrace.


How to get there:



There will be a reserved parking area in Forrest St (between Quinlan and Railway) for “interesting” cars. We would particularly like to see cars of the era – “humpy” Holdens, Vanguards, Hillmans, Ford Anglias, Consuls, Zephyrs, Customlines, Humbers, Chevs and the like, but also other Historic cars from any period up to the fifties. The event will be listed, so that you can give the concessionally-licensed machine a run. If you’re a member of an appropriate group, please spread the word. People are free to make their own way there, but a convoy will leave Centrepont Shopping Centre carpark Midland (opposite the Railway Station) at 8:00am, to arrive in Goomalling by about 10 - 10:30am, and leaving Goomalling at about 2:30pm. We are hoping to arrange a support vehicle (with car trailer) to tail this group. Competitors will need to be on the road a good deal earlier: Scrutineering will be in the pits (cnr Railway and Throssell – approach via Throssell) from 8:00am, and as usual, no sticker, no start.

The competition will be a one car at a time sprint from James St, west along Railway Terrace, in and out of the Railway Station, to a garage finish just past Hoddy St. There will be a sighting run, and at least four timed runs, with trophies for the fastest in any class (see VSCCWA Standing Regs – Hillclimbs & Sprints) that has at least three entrants, plus an overall FTD. It is anticipated to finish competition by around 3 O’clock, a quick clean up, and home for tea.

Goomalling Town will of course be joining the party – food and drink will be available at a number of commercial premises, and redolent of the era, the CWA will have a stall.



I appeal to you one and all, despite the short notice, to come along and demonstrate to our national body that there is a demand for this kind of celebration of our motoring history, that it is important to you as members of the historic car movement, and to support the people of Goomalling.
