Saturday & Sunday 7th & 8th April 2018

You are invited to enter the Northam Motor Sport Festival in the Northam townsite. This is a multi-club motoring event involving Hillclimb, Regularity and Motorkhana over the two days. The Northam Mitre10 Flying 50 "round the houses" is a round of the 2018 W.A. Historic Regularity Drivers Championship.

Proposed program for Saturday 7th April.

The Lindsay Monk Mt Ommanney Hillclimb track will be open at 7:30am with the onsite scrutineering bay commencing at 8:00am. Practice is scheduled to start at 9:00am. A compulsory Drivers' Briefing before the commencement of practice runs will be held in the assembly area 15 mins before each group runs. All vehicles complying with the 2018 VSCC Standing Regulations for Hillclimbs & Sprints Club Championship will be eligible for entry.

This year's Minson Motorkhana is a twilight event and will be held in the Minson Ave car park in Northam from 5 to 8pm. Scrutiny will be held from 2pm to 4pm in the car park. A compulsory drivers briefing will commence at 4.30pm at the Timing Tent. Start of First Test will be at 5:00pm.

Proposed Program for Sunday 8th April.

The Northam Mitre10 Flying 50 will be held on the street circuit in the Northam townsite. A compulsory drivers' briefing will be held at **8:30am** in the paddock/assembly area, near the commentary caravan. Practice is scheduled to start at **9:30am** with the competition events scheduled to start at 10:30am.

The regularity events will be conducted for vehicles complying with the regulations for 5th Category Historic Cars Groups A, C, F, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, as outlined in the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport. It is requirement of entry that all drivers help with the secondary fencing dismantle after the last event.

Scrutineering

Metro scrutineering will be held on **Saturday 24th March** between 0800 and 1200pm at the North Metropolitan TAFE off Lloyd Street Midland.

Albany & Bunbury competitor's scrutiny will be held Saturday 24th March or as advised, at a local venue to be advised or;

Country competitors' scrutiny will be held at the venue on Sunday 8th April from 07:30am.

Presentations

There will be a trophy presentation, drinks and nibbles at the Bernard Park Sound shell at approximately 5:45pm. Please come along and support the winners or even pick up a trophy or two. There will be trophies for lowest point scores of each regularity group.

Entries CLOSE Friday 16th March 2018, so get yours in early to be sure of a place!
