## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

### 1 EVENT TITLE, DATE & VENUE

The event shall be known as the VSCCWA Stampede Hillclimb, to be held on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2018 at Jacks Hill adjacent to Barbagallo Raceway, Wattle Ave East, Neerabup.

### 2 ORGANISATION AND STATUS

- (a) The event shall be held under the International Sporting Code of the Federation Internationale de l'automobile (FIA), the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Confederation of Australian Motor Sport Ltd (CAMS), the Speed Event Standing Regulations, 2018 CAMS Western Australian Historic Sprint and Hillclimb Championship, The Vintage Sports Car Club of WA 2018 Standing Regulations, these Supplementary Regulations and any Further Regulations and instructions to competitors that may be issued. This event will be conducted under and in accordance with the CAMS Risk Management and OH&S policies, which can be found at [www.cams.com.au](http://www.cams.com.au). Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. The event shall be a **Multi Club Hillclimb**.

### 4 ENTRIES

- a) **Opening date:** On publication of these Regulations  
b) **Closing date:** Friday 16<sup>th</sup> November.  
c) **Entry Fee:** \$70.00 incl GST payable to The Vintage Sports Car Club of WA (Inc.). No monies will be refunded after the Monday prior to the event.  
d) **Entry lodgement address:** VSCC Entries, PO Box 7277 Spearwood WA 6163  
e) **Tax Invoice:** If you require a tax invoice, please contact Sheryl Swarbrick on 0416 025  
f) **Restricted entries:** The organisers will restrict entries to 100 participants and reserve the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason therefore in accordance with NCR 83. A minimum of 30 entries is required for the event to proceed. Preference will be given to members of those Clubs represented on the organizing committee.  
g) A parent or guardian of an entrant under 18 years of age must sign consent on the Entry Form.

### 5 VEHICLES

All Vehicles (open event) as per 2018 VSCCWA Standing Regulations for Sprint / Hill Climb Club Championship are eligible for entry (Schedule A & B of the current CAMS Manual). All Fuel must comply with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual. Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

### 6 START/NUMBER OF RUNS

- (a) All competitors are required to register at sign on desk, located adjacent to the Start Line.  
(b) Drivers briefing will be at 1:45pm with practice scheduled to start at 2:00pm. Each competitor will be allowed one practice run and must not be driven at full competitive speeds. Practice times do not count for competition results.  
(c) The event is scheduled to start immediately following practice. Each competitor shall have a minimum of 3 timed runs. **Additional runs may be held if time permits.** Competitors whom are also volunteers shall have priority to compete in all instances.

- (d) In each group cars will run in any order as they line up. The onus is on each competitor to make sure they have their allocated number of runs.
- (e) The event is scheduled to finish by approximately 6:00pm.
- (f) Event Organisers reserve the right to cancel, abandon or postpone the event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual.

## 8 LICENCE REQUIREMENTS

Competitors must hold a minimum of a CAMS Level 2S or 2SJ Licence. Competitors must be a member of a CAMS-affiliated Club in WA.

## 9 VEHICLE SCRUTINY

All entrants must present for scrutiny, and all vehicles must carry a compliant Fire-extinguisher.

### (i) City Competitors

Scrutiny will be held on **Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> November** between 0800 and 1130am at the North Metropolitan TAFE off Lloyd Street, Midland WA.

**If a city competitor is unable to make scrutiny on the above date, and fails to make an arrangement with the Chief Scrutineer there may be a \$50.00 late fee to be paid to take part in country scrutiny.**

### (ii) Country Competitors:

**Albany & Bunbury Entrants:** Saturday 24<sup>th</sup> November or as advised, at a local venue (to be advised) **or** Scrutiny will be held on Saturday 1<sup>st</sup> December from 1:00pm at the Jack's Hill paddock.

### (iii) All Entrants

- (a) Your apparel and helmet complying with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual must be presented for inspection and approval at time of scrutineering.
- (b) A CAMS Car Club Membership card, current CAMS Competition Licence, and CAMS Vehicle log book (if issued) must be produced during scrutiny and on request during the meeting.
- (c) Race numbers will be provided at registration on the day.
- (d) No car may participate unless it has passed scrutiny.
- (e) Any car or driver may be prohibited from practice or the competition for safety reasons.
- (f) Vehicles must be adequately muffled to comply with noise restrictions.

## 11 DRIVERS' BRIEFING

A compulsory Drivers' Briefing before the commencement of practice runs will be held adjacent to the Start Line at 15 mins before each group runs. Any competitor failing to attend or arriving late at the Briefing should seek out the Clerk of the Course who will consult with the Stewards to determine whether they are permitted to run and under what conditions, e.g. reduced number of runs.

## 12 DETERMINATION OF WINNERS

The results, overall and for each eligible class, will be determined by the fastest overall time of the day not including the practice run and ranked in ascending order of time. Should two or more competitors record the same time the competitor next best fastest time shall be deemed superior. Points will also be awarded for class winners as per the 2017 WA Historic Sprint and Hillclimb State Championship regulations.

Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual.

## 13 ALCOHOL, DRUGS AND OTHER SUBSTANCES

Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
