



## Northam Motor Sport Festival 2021

10 & 11 April

We invite your entry for the Northam Motor Sport Festival on the weekend after Easter. This is a multi-club event comprising the Lindsay Monk Hill-climb at Mt Ommanney on the Saturday and the famous Northam Flying 50 regularity in the town centre on the Sunday. ### Saturday

The hill-climb gets under way at 9:00am after a drivers' briefing at 8:30. If we get a large number of entries, we may conduct a second driver's briefing at around 10:30am and the second group of cars would run from 11:00am. If this second group is available and you'd prefer to be in the later group, please let us know.

There will be entertainment on Saturday afternoon in Northam with a monster truck display and we encourage competitors to support the Northam business community by staying overnight. However, if you're planning to stay, we suggest you book your accommodation now.

### Sunday

The Bendigo Bank Northam Flying 50 will be held on the street circuit in the Northam town centre. All drivers must attend the drivers' briefing in the paddock area in Minson Avenue at 8:30am.

Regularity events will be conducted for all vehicles complying with the regulations for 5<sup>th</sup> Category Historic Cars in Groups A, C, F, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U & V as outlined in the current Motorsport Australia Manual.

We ask all drivers to stay back after the event on Sunday afternoon to help our volunteers dismantle the secondary fencing around the circuit.

### Scrutiny

Under Motorsport Australia's *Return to Race Rules*, there will be no compulsory pre-event scrutiny and all competitors must complete the *Self-scrutiny Checklist* and *Statement of Vehicle Compliance* included with this letter. Entries will not be accepted unless both forms are submitted with the entry form and payment.

We will be offering a voluntary pre-season scrutiny at Caversham in March at a date to be determined. We encourage competitors to present their vehicles, particularly if your vehicle has not been in a competition event for a while or you are a first-time competitor.

### Presentations

We will present trophies to group winners at the VSCC monthly meeting at 6:30pm on Monday 3 May at the Light Car Club rooms opposite 37 Moojebing St, Bassendean.
