You are invited to enter the Northam Bendigo Bank Flying 50 "Around the Houses" event and the Lindsay Monk Hillclimb in the Northam townsite. These are State Championship motoring events involving Regularity and Hillclimb over the two days.

### ***Proposed program for Saturday 4th April.***

The Lindsay Monk Hillclimb, to be held on 4<sup>th</sup> April 2020 at Mitchell Avenue, Mt. Ommanney Northam Western Australia. Practice is scheduled to start at 9:00am. A compulsory Drivers' Briefing before the commencement of practice will be held in the pit/assembly area at 15 mins before each group runs. The Event is scheduled to finish by approximately 1:00pm

### ***Proposed Program for Sunday 5th April.***

The Northam Bendigo Bank Flying 50 will be held on the street circuit in the Northam townsite. A compulsory drivers' briefing will be held at **8:30am** in the paddock/assembly area, near the commentary caravan. Practice is scheduled to start at **9:30am** with the competition events scheduled to start at 10:30am. The program of events may be modified on the day.

The Round the Houses event will be conducted for vehicles complying with the regulations for 5th Category Historic Cars Groups A, C, F, J, K, L, M, N, O, P, Q, R, S, T, U, V, as outlined in the current Motorsport Australia Manual of Motor Sport.

It is requirement of entry that all drivers help with the secondary fencing dismantle after the last event.

### ***Scrutineering***

Metro scrutineering will be held on **Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March** between 8:00am and 11:00am at the North Metropolitan TAFE off Lloyd Street Midland.

Albany & Bunbury competitor's scrutiny will be at a local venue as advised.

Country competitors' scrutiny will be held at the venue on from 07:30am.
